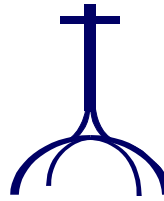
### Fr. Lankeit's Book-of-the-Month *A Father's Tale* by Michael O'Brien

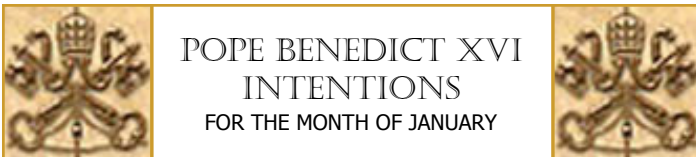

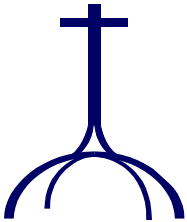

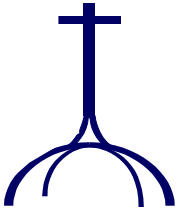
